### New features:

- Cataloguing / Lists / Item Barcodes / Check A printout has been added to the display of mismatched barcodes and item numbers.
- Overdues / Notes / Emails The email format has been reduced to text format only.
- Controls / General Controls / Email Settings Support for TSL/SSL has been added. This is needed by some smtp email systems, such as Google's if smtp.gmail.com. Only tick this box if the email service requires it.
- Reports / Catalogue Reports / Print with Covers Can now sort the list by item number, title, author, call number, location or sublocation.
- Borrowers / Labels / Print Barcode labels / Class sheets Added the current date to the top line.
- Slight behind-the-scenes change to the circulation records in the database.
- Updated manuals: Controls and Overdues.
- Updated fact sheets: Emailing Overdues.

# The Bookmark 10.3.9 update is now available

## New features:

• Stocktaking / List missing items. The Log Items and Missing Items displays have been revised slightly. On the list missing items screen, multiple entries

can be highlighted and when Assign Status is clicked, it only affects the highlighted entries, not the entire list as before. If no entries are highlighted, then the whole list is assigned the status.

- Controls / Search Controls. Tick a box to show Collection (Genre) field instead of Locations in list of titles found.
- Cataloguing / Import Items / Import Lexiles. After lexiles are imported, a list of titles that have been updated is displayed.
- Cataloguing / Labels / Print Spine Labels. For manual entry only, a tick box has been added that prints an entire page of one label. Each line is a label. Also, if an underscore is used in a call number, it is printed as a space but it does not split at that spot. This allows two or three things on a line, and little stickers can be made.
- **Circulation / Returns**. When returning a box and the dialog appears, the "Return Some" button now allows returning selected entries. It pops up a list of the box members and you can tick the ones to return. This is a change.
- Cataloguing. There is a new Covers / Images button on the menu, which replaces Search. Covers is no longer in the Lists area.
- Cataloguing / Covers Images. Covers can be downloaded from the pool
  used by CPAC. Click on the File menubar option at the top then "Get Covers
  from CPAC". Bookmark will try to download cover images that match any
  ISBNs without covers. This can be a very slow process (overnight) but can
  also be an easy way to add many covers. Internet access is required the
  same as for easy updating. If Bookmark cannot directly access its website,
  this function will fail.
- Controls / Due Dates. Ranges of Holiday Dates can be specified. If a due date falls within a range, it is automatically recalculated outside the range and assigned. This also affects overdue notices, too, as before.
- Cataloguing / Export Items / CPAC format. A problem exporting data for CPAC has been fixed that caused some items not to be found in searches or blank lines to appear.
- All manuals and fact sheets have been updated.

## The Bookmark 10.3.9 update is now available

Some of the new features are:

- Stocktaking / List missing items. Can highlight multiple entries and assign change status only to those entries. If no entries are highlighted, then everything listed is changed.
- Cataloguing / Labels / Print Spine Labels. Added Save and Retrieve buttons. This provides a quick, easy method to save the current list of items and later retrieve it without having to use the more complex Export/Import system.
- Cataloguing / AddEdit Items. The Content Type field can now hold multiple values. A semi-colon separates each entry - e.g. Text; Still image. This would apply to an illustrated book. A "3 dot" button can be clicked to choose multiple entries.
- Overdues / Overdue Lists / List. Class costs button has been added. Lists
  each class showing the total number of overdues and total cost. The "Include
  cost" checkbox must be ticked for this to work properly.
- Borrowers / Update Borrowers / Import. The EDSAS import for DECD schools has been updated. In EDSAS itself there is a new "Student data export for Bookmark" report, found in Transfer Reports. This new report from EDSAS contains additional email data. The regular EDSAS format handles both the older style and new style reports.
- Slight changes made to the database and a major change has been made behind-the-scenes but should have no visible effect.

## New features

- Controls / Circulation Controls: Added "Show list of names below enter barcode". Lists students from a selected class in the visible area beneath the barcode entry box. Unlike the droplist, this list stays visible.
- Reports / Catalogue Reports: Added Export for Accelerated Reader.
- Borrowers / Added: Generate barcode button added.
- Cataloguing / Lists / Check for inactive websites: Added check author links to test.
- Cataloguing / Linking: Added a control to list duplicate titles that are not linked.
- Borrowers / Update: Added Scan function. Borrower barcodes can be scanned into assign classes, year levels and/or borrower types.
- Borrowers / Update, Import: Added Edumate format.
- Cataloguing / Boxes: Showing status is optional in View Contents.
- Controls / Resource Lists: Added call number to resource list printout.
- Controls / Circulation Controls: Passwords are now specific to each setup instead of the same for all setups.
- Search: An asterisk can be entered for a Title search along with a search limiter like a Lexile number or level. This lists all titles with that number.
- Cataloguing / Import Items: Added import text files. This allows mass
  importing item data from a tab-delimited or csv file which may have been
  produced in Excel, Notepad or Word. Special rules need to be followed when
  producing the item list. These are detailed in the revised Cataloguing manual
  in the Import Items area.

New features

- Stocktaking: A popup list now appears when scanning a box. It is similar to the one that appears in Returns.
- Stocktaking: in Missing Items, "View Members of Boxes" button has been added. This displays a list of all missing items that are members of boxes.
- Stocktaking: sublocation has been added as a criteria to Missing Items.
- Cataloguing: in Lists > Check for Inactive Websites. This has been improved and the display changed. It now allows testing of websites in the list.

### **CPAC**

CPAC is Bookmark's Internet search system. It allows searching one or more catalogues from any device anywhere, inside or outside a school's network firewall. CPAC works by exporting data from Bookmark and uploading it to a website so it becomes available online.

CPAC has been upgraded. It has a new, faster search engine and a new database system. Uploading data is much quicker, too, and contains additional data.

The CPAC search pages remain unaltered. This is a behind-the-scenes change. All existing CPAC databases have been upgraded to the new format.

The CPAC manual and application form have been completely revised.

Along with the "new" CPAC, Bookmark 10's CPAC export has been substantially changed. CPAC users are urged to upgrade to Bookmark 10.3.1 and then re-export and re-upload data in order to take advantage of the improvements. Go to Cataloguing > Export Items > CPAC format.
