

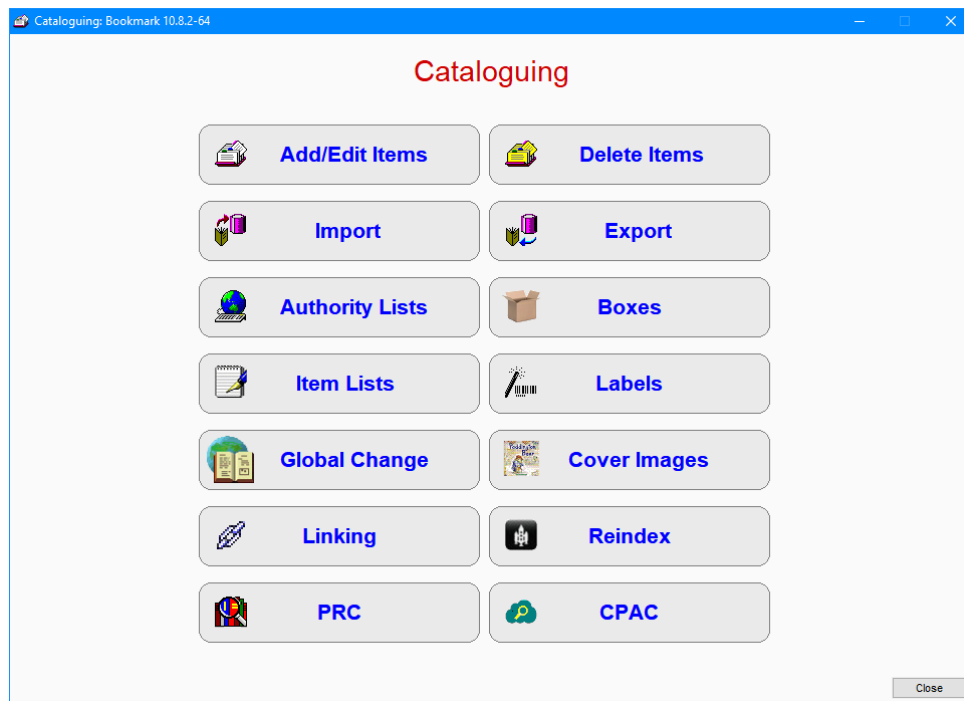
# BOOKMARK FACT SHEET

## Customizing Menu Button Colours

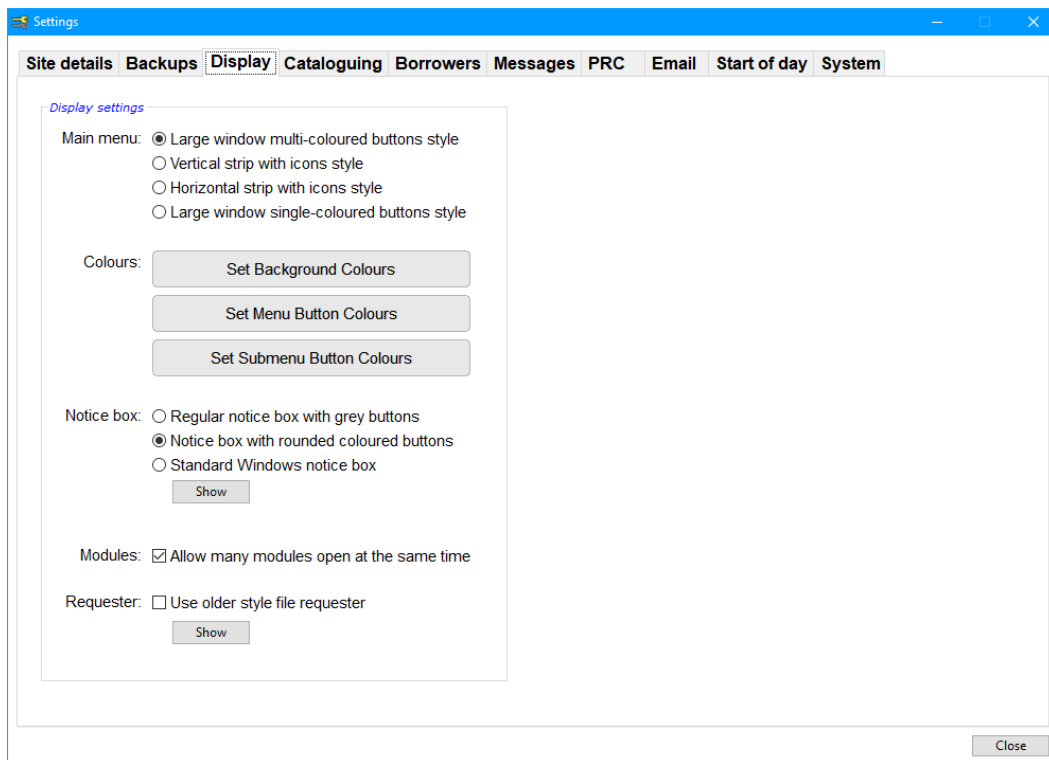
Bookmark's module menus display large pushbuttons.

The colours of these buttons can be changed. By default they are light grey background with blue text. (Note if you upgraded from Windows XP or Windows 7 the colours might be darker. Do the below to improve.)

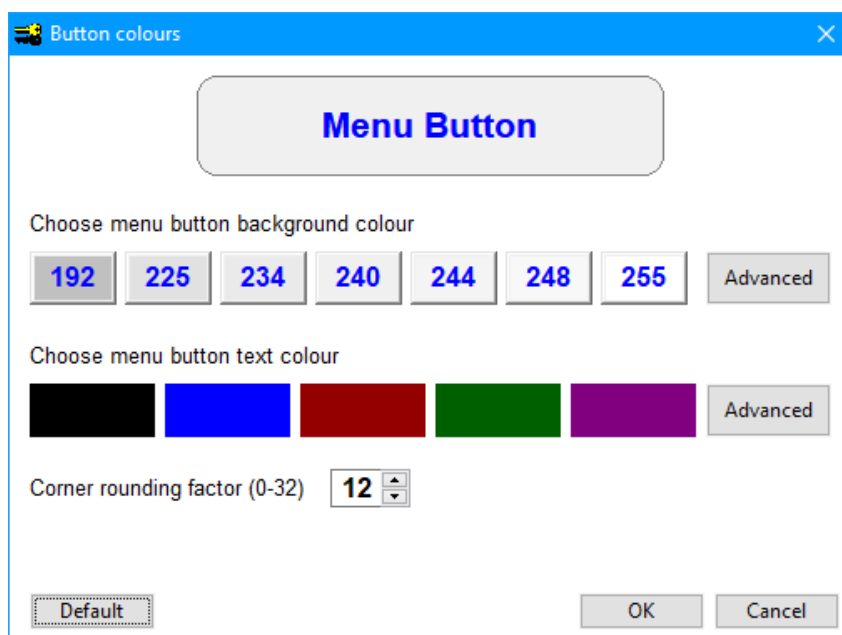


To change the colours:

Controls > Settings > Display tab.



Click on *Set Menu Button Colours*.



The button background colour can be changed by clicking on one of the numbered buttons, or by clicking on Advanced. Advanced allows any colour. The default background is 240. Older versions of Windows were set to darker greys like 224 and even 192.

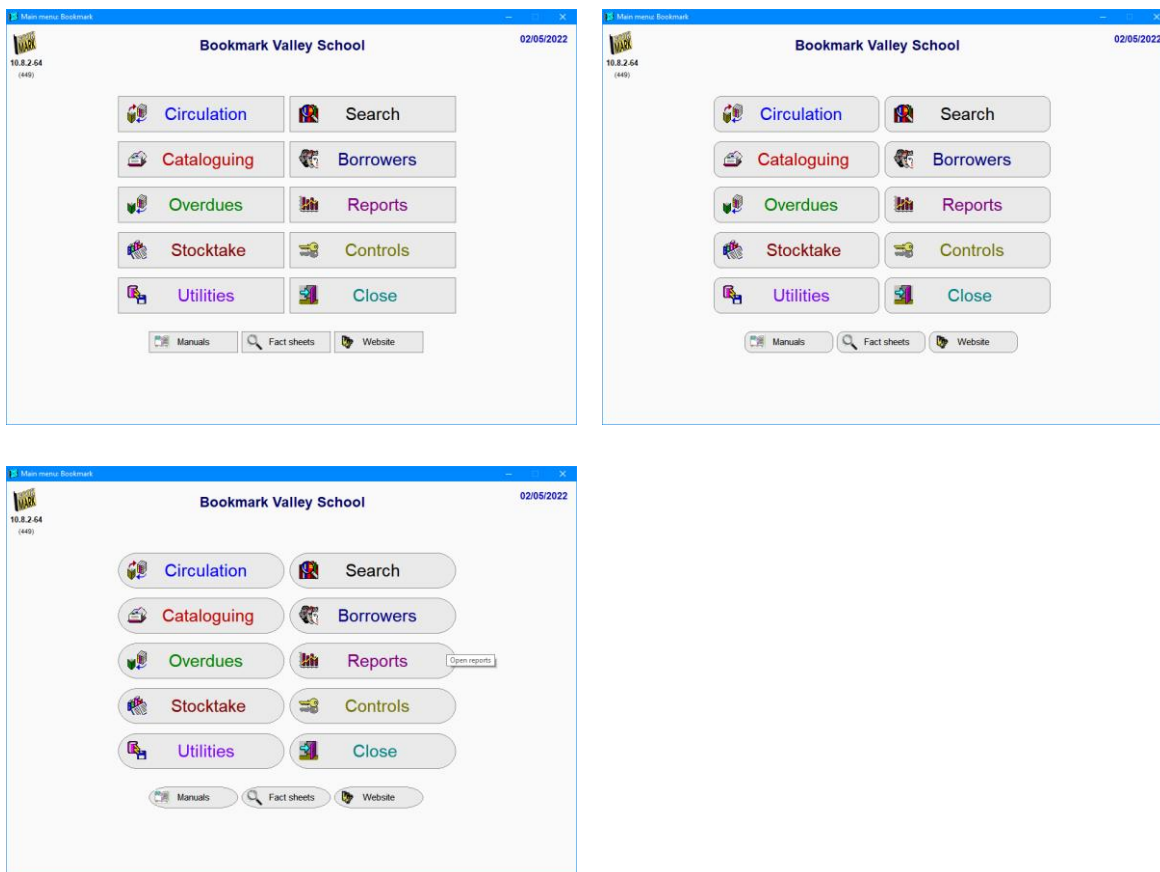
The button text colour can be set by clicking on the coloured rectangles or using Advanced.

Buttons have rounded corners. The "rounding factor" determines the curve. A rounding factor of 0 gives square corners. Maximum allowed is 32.

Default resets the button backgrounds to 240, the text to blue and the rounding factor to 12.

Changes do not take place immediately. Close Settings. Close Controls and close Bookmark. Re-opening Bookmark will show all the changes.

Below, rounding factors are set at 0, 12 and 32.



The submenu colours control works the same way but applies to button menus in deeper layers. The default text colour is black but can be changed, too.

The text colours on the Main Menu buttons cannot be changed.

The background colours on all modules can be set separately. Each module can have its own colour.
