

# BOOKMARK FACT SHEET

## Customizing Module Colours

May 2022

Bookmark allows each module to have a different background colour.

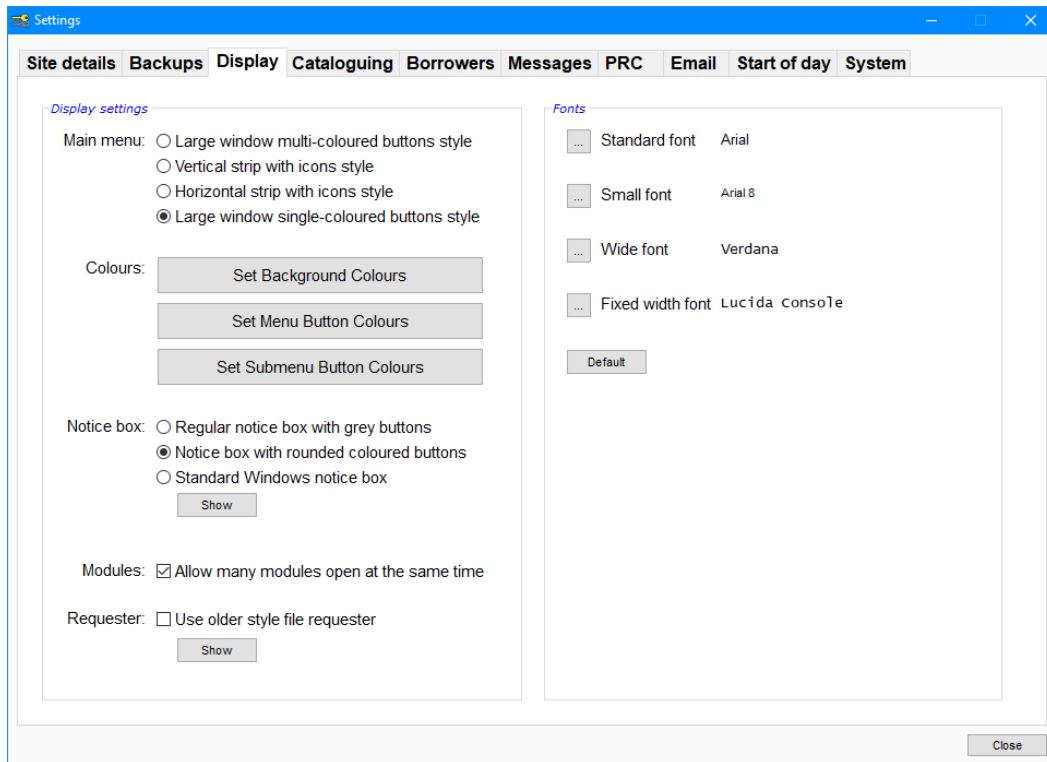


By default all modules have the same off-white background colour.

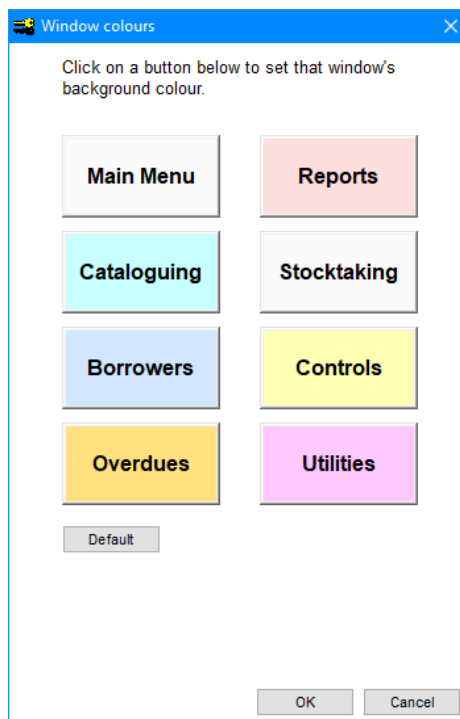
If you have upgraded the version of Windows, the background colours may appear a darker grey.

To change the colours:

Controls > Settings > Display tab.



Click on *Set Background Colours*.



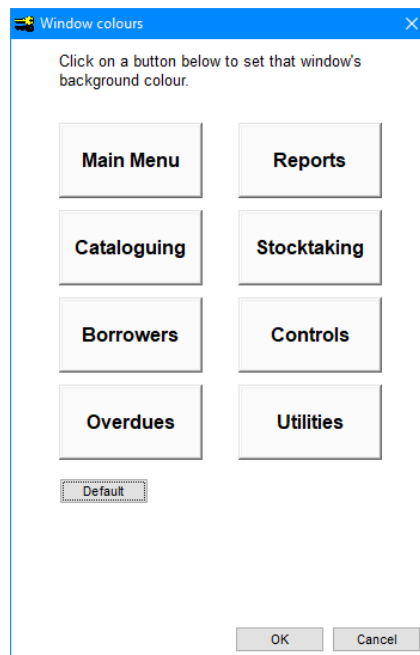
Click on the button for each module to be changed.



The pastel colours shown provide good contrast with black text. The text colour in Bookmark is usually black and cannot be changed. Readability is affected by colour acuity and a good contrast makes for easier reading. Click on a colour then OK to set. Repeat for other modules.

The Advanced button allows setting colours not already provided.

Click on the Default button to set the colours back to normal.



Note: if your background is a dark or medium grey, clicking on Default may lighten. The Windows operating system changed default backgrounds between Windows XP, Windows 7 and Windows 10.
